

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO8013) affecting the Belaugh Lane from 430m southwest of its junction with Market Street for 30m south westwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Tunstead to facilitate level crossing maintenance works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 00:00 and 09:00 from 9th June to 7th July 2024 only whilst signs indicating closures are in place, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 7th January 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

NB – This closure is only anticipated to take place on 2 nights, being the 9th June 2024 and the 7th July 2024.

Alternative route is via: Belaugh Lane, Belaugh Green Lane, Grange Farm Lane, Tunstead Road, Coltishall Lane, Market Street, Belaugh Lane (Hoveton, Belaugh, Coltishall, Tunstead).

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 7th January 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
